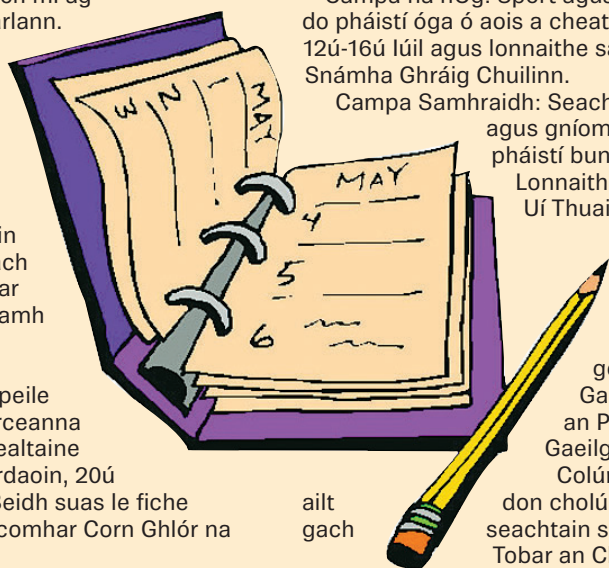

VISIT TO LOUGH DERG

Monsignor Richard Mohan is once again offering a varied programme of the usual three-day pilgrimage: one-day retreat, quiet days, and a day for families. Along with Confirmation and school retreats, and the life's journey series of workshops, the pilgrimage will provide opportunities for many. In 2009, the greatest number of pilgrims attended Lough Derg than other years. The three-day pilgrimage involves a fast from midnight, remaining in your bare feet from 10am until you leave the pilgrimage. There are nine stations on the island, only one meal in 20 hours consisting of black tea and dry toast. The pilgrimage starts on 1 June to 13 August, and the cost is €55, including boat fare and accommodation. One-day retreats are available during the month of May, and again from mid-August to 21 September. The cost of €30 includes boat fare and lunch. Special rates for groups of 15 or more.
