Tá an-áthas ar Glór Cheatharlach na sonraí faoi Ócáid Ghaeilge 2011 a thionólfar san Ostán Seven Oaks ar Dé Máirt, 18 Eanáir ag 8.00i.n. a fhógair. Beidh an pearsa mór féin Mícheál Ó Muircheartaigh i láthair mar aoi speisialta na hócáide agus déanfaidh sé An Doirseoir a sheoladh go hoifigiúil.

'Séard atá sa phacáiste ilmheán dhátheangach atá díreach eisithe ag Glór Cheatharlach ná scéal beatha Sholanus Uí Chathasaigh, Caipisíneach a rugadh i Wisconsin, Meiriceá de thuismitheoirí a saolaidh in Éirinn.

Bíodh is gur oirníodh an tAthair Solanus, O.F.M., níor ceadaíodh riamh dó faoistine a éisteacht na seanmóir a thabhairt mar dar le huachtaráin na gCaipisíneach ní raibh sé acadúil a dhóthain. Ní ón altóir ná i mbosca na faoistine a d'fhógair sé an soiscéal ach ag doras na mainistreach. B'é an doirseoir é agus ba chuige a tháinig daoine ina mílte ag lorg comhairle agus treoir spioradálta. Ní fios an mbeadh an tionchar céanna ag an Ath. Solanus ar chróithe an oiread san daoine dá mbeadh sé i bhfeighil gnáthchúraí na sagartóireachta. Tuigtear go gcuirfidh foghlaimoírí fásta na teanga ach go háirithe an-fháilte roimh an pacáiste dhátheangach agus beidh an-tóir air chomh maith mar áis do churaclam na Gaeilge in iarbhunscóileanna na tíre. Beidh sé ar fáil go forleathan tar éis a bheith seolta.

Ag an ócáid ar an 18 Eanáir chomh maith bronnfar teastais agus an fáinne ar rannpháirtithe a d'fhreastail ar chúrsaí Gaeilge le Gaelchultúr a reachtáladh i gCeatharlach le blianta beag anuas agus déanfar sraith nua 2011 na gCúrsaí

a sheoladh go hoifigiúil. Agus beidh ionadaithe ó Fhoras na Gaeilge i láthair chun deontas ar fiú €164,300 faoin Scéim Phobail Gaeilge 2011-2013 a bhronnadh ar Glór Cheatharlach.

Dreoilín Cheatharlach 2010


