## Cúrsa Léiriú Teilifíse i bPortláirge

TÁ an spriocdátá d'áiteanna ar an gCúrsa Ard Dioplóma i Léiriú Teilifíse le Nemeton agus Institiúid Teicneolaíochta Phortláirge, WIT, ag druidim linn go luath. Rinne WIT agus Nemeton forbairt ar an gcúrsa uathúil leibhéal 8 seo chun céimithe a chur ar fáil go mbeidh sé ar a gcumas dul díreach isteach i dtionscal na teilifíse.

Tá sé mar aidhm ag an gcúrsa na scileanna riachtanacha a mhúineadh do dhaoine ón gceantar chun go dtógfaidh siad tús áite sa tionscal sna blianta amach romhainn.
