In the gymnastics competition on Friday last in St. Leo's, Lauren Holohan won the girls under 12 competition with Roisin Brennan taking the silver medal. On the following day, the local area won no less than 6 gold, 4 silver and 4 bronze medals. The gold medal winners were Nicole Pratt (girls

under 10 freestyle), Alana Pratt (girls under 14 freestyle), Radinka Pratt (girls under 10 backstroke), Vicky Kidd (girls under 14 backstroke), Conor Crowley (boys under 12 freestyle) and Shea Byrne (boys under 12 breaststroke).
