Clár Fhéile an Fhómhair seolta

TÁ an fómhar buailte linn agus déanfar ceiliúradh ar an séasúr álainn seo thar naoi lá i rith Fhéile an Fhómhair i gCeatharlach. Seoladh clár na féile an tseachtain seo caite agus mar is gnáthach tá sé lán d'imeachtaí dhátheangach le ceol, sean-nós, scannáin, drámaíocht, puipéadóireacht, scéalaíocht, amhránaíocht, ceardlanna, siúlóid agus níos mó fós a leanfaidh ó 3ú go 11ú Deireadh Fómhair. 'Sé téama na féile i mbliana ná "Ag Ceiliúradh 40 Bliain na Gaeilge i gCeatharlach 1973-2013". Glacfar páirt sa mharatón cainte Comhrá Ollmhór 24/7 agus eagrófar Ceiliúradh Cainte i scoileanna an cheantair. Tionólfar ócáid cheiliúrtha san Ostan Seven Oaks chun aitheantas a thabhairt do phríomh bhuaicphointí na Gaeilge i gCeatharlach thar daichead bliain.

Beidh blas an fhómhair ag gabháil leis na himeachtaí i rith na féile le Lá Náisiúnta na gCrann ar an 10ú Deireadh Fómhair nuair a mholfar do gach éinne, idir óg agus fásta, cuairt a thabhairt ar an bhforaois, siúl sa choill nó fiú an t-am a ghlacadh chun áilleacht na gcrann agus dathanna an nádúir mórthimpeall orainn a thabhairt faoi deara. Ag leanúint le téama na timpeallachta eagrófar Siúlóid Cois Bearbha agus siúlóid ar shráideanna Cheatharlach bunaithe ar an úrscéal stairiúil Lucinda Sly. Beidh ceardlanna sa rince sean-nóis leis an sár-rinceoir Irene Cunningham agus ceardlanna scéalaíochta le Aideen McBride.

Níl aon ghanntanas d'imeachtaí do scoileanna ar chlár Fhéile an Fhómhair idir Spraoicheist, Tráth na gCeist agus comórtas ealaíne an fhómhair. Leireofar seó puipéadóireachta as Gaeilge i Halla na Gaelscoile. Tá gach eolas seolta chuig scoileanna uile an chontae agus iarrtar ar mhúinteoirí clárú gan mhoill.
